
Dear Applicant:

This refers to the above-captioned minor application to change effective radiated power.

Mexican Interference. Our study of the application reveals that the proposal is located 16.1 kilometers from the common border with Mexico. *The Agreement Between the Government of the United States of America and the Government of the United Mexican States Relating to the FM Broadcasting Service in the Band 88-108 MHz* requires that translators located within 125 kilometers of the common border must be notified to Mexico, (Paragraph 2.1.4). Therefore, notice of this proposal was given to Mexico. We have since been advised that Mexico objects to this proposal based on lack of protection to TV Channel 6, Tijuana, Mexico. Accordingly, the application will be dismissed.

Application Dismissed. In light of the above, Application BPFT-20020328AAT is unacceptable for filing pursuant to 47 C.F.R. § 73.3566 and IS HEREBY DISMISSED. This action is taken pursuant to 47 C.F.R. § 0.283.
